Stephen S. Duckels has served the public for 14 years as a property tax appraiser and now as Yuba County Assessor. As an appraiser he helped navigate the Yuba County Assessor's office through the Great Recession and Cascade Fire before being elected Assessor in the June 2018 primary election.

Duckels' primary focus as Assessor has been to insure his office treats taxpayers fairly, provides superior customer service, and operates cost effectively. He is working to leverage technology to create greater office efficiencies as well as better public access to property tax information.

Duckels holds a Bachelor of Science Degree from Oregon State University in Crop and Soil Science with a minor in Agricultural Resource Economics. He is a third generation Yuba County resident and resides with his wife and two young children in Browns Valley on the Duckels Ranch, which has been in his family for over 6 decades.

Duckels is actively involved in the community as a member of the Kiwanis Club of Marysville, Yuba Sutter Farm Bureau, and the Yuba County Community Services Committee.
