# Modernizing The Voting Experience



- ONE VOTER
- ONE DAY
- ONE LOCATION
- ONE DEVICE



Voters can only vote at one assigned location on one day between 7:00 am and 8:00 pm.



Voting equipment is limited to one device per voting location.



Paper Rosters are printed in advance, and often require supplemental printing.



Vote By Mail can be difficult to use for many with one drop off location before Election Day.



- ALL VOTERS
- 10 DAYS
- UP TO 5 LOCATIONS
- ALL DEVICES



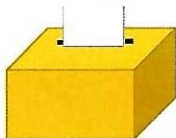
Voters could mail their ballots or drop their ballots off at any of the 4 drop off locations, or vote at one of the 3-5 Vote Centers.



Fully accessible voting equipment would be available at every vote center.



Electronic rosters accessing data in real time and would allow for same day registration.



Vote By Mail would be easier to use with 4 drop off locations available throughout the County.

Senate Bill 450 allows for more opportunities for California's voters. Sutter County has been selected as a pilot county for Vote Centers for the June 2018 Gubernatorial Election.
